Students will learn in a workroom environment using industrial machines and professional tools and supplies to complete sample projects following instructor demonstrations and detailed step-by-step instructions.

Workroom Tech is owned and operated by Susan Woodcock and Rodger Walker, owners of Home Dec Gal and producers of Custom Workroom Conference. Located in the foothills of the Blue Ridge Mountains in Tryon, NC, Workroom Tech is at the center of a charming town, within easy walking distance of restaurants, shops and galleries.

CLASS DETAILS

- Classes run from 9:00 am to 6:00 pm including a one hour lunch break, and from one to four days depending on the complexity of the topic.
- Detailed step-by-step written instructions are required for attendees. Instructors will provide the curriculum.
- Classrooms will be set up based on the class topic with tools and supplies ready to use.
- Instructors will provide a list of tools, supplies and fabric amounts for completion of projects.
- There will be six students maximum for each hands-on class.

INSTRUCTOR SELECTION PROCESS

We will carefully consider all programs submitted. Final selections are based on instructor qualifications and experience, program quality and relevance for workroom education. You will be notified whether you have been selected or not as an instructor, and your submission will be kept for future class openings.

INSTRUCTOR COMPENSATION

Instructors will be paid a per day rate and reimbursed for travel expenses, lodging, meals and shipping of class samples and materials. If selected as an instructor you will receive a complete outline of your compensation, reimbursement, non-compete restrictions, and conditions before your contract is finalized.
